	(2) Respond to messages and engage followers and others who reach out to the organization on social media.
	(3) Develop social media calendar and content for approval
	4) Schedule weekly post
	5) Actively engage other non-profit organizations, identify potential sponsors and develop engagement strategy
	6) Promotes the causes of the organization online and offline. This includes sharing awareness information on social media as well as on the organization's blog pages.
	(7) Works with Programs Director on any other task as may be deemed necessary.
